

## CBAAC Colloquium 2013 | Toward a new Pan-Africanism: Deploying Anthropology, Archaeology, History and Philosophy in the service of Africa and the Diaspora, Kingston, Jamaica

Historians are still debating the demographic, economic, social, cultural and religio-metaphysical consequences of enslavement, the slave trade, and the “middle passage” on/for Africa, Africans, and people of African descent in the Caribbean, the Americas and elsewhere.

It is extremely difficult to settle the debate with population figures everybody will agree with. However, the long term psycho-behavioral consequences on the survivors, both in Africa and the Diaspora, have never been addressed systematically.

Authors whose abstracts are accepted would be notified not later than **15th of May, 2013**, while all papers for presentation must be received in electronic format not later than **15th July, 2013**.




## Slavery, Migration and Contemporary Bondage in Africa


## Agricultural Development and Food Security in Africa. The Impact of Chinese, Indian and Brazilian Investments




## The Sexual History of the Global South. Sexual Politics in Africa, Asia, and Latin America

The resulting collection touches the issue of racism but equally about moments of pure idealism and 'romance' in Sino-African history.



Dubbed 'land grabs' in the media, large-scale land acquisitions have become one of the most talked about and contentious topics amongst those studying, working in or writing about Africa.








## Africa and the War on Drugs



## Cuba and Angola. Fighting for Africa's Freedom and Our Own

Twenty-five years ago, in March 1988, the army of South Africa's apartheid regime was dealt a crushing defeat by Cuban, Angolan, and Namibian combatants at the battle of Cuito Cuanavale in Angola. That triumph, South Africa's future president Nelson Mandela proclaimed, marked “a milestone in the history of the struggle for southern African liberation.”

With the victory at Cuito Cuanavale, Angola's sovereignty was secured. Namibia's independence was won. The deepening revolutionary struggle in South Africa received a powerful boost. Between 1975 and 1991 some 425,000 Cubans volunteered for duty in Angola in response to requests from the Angolan government to help defend the newly independent country against multiple invasions by South Africa's white-supremacist regime, backed by its allies in Washington and elsewhere.






## Les Royaumes Wolof dans L'Espace Senegambien (XIIIe-XVIIIe Siecle)




### Eglise Catholique, Etat et Société Civile au Cameroun de 1884 a nos Jours




### Carnival – Theory and Practice




### SheMurenga: The Zimbabwean Women's Movement 1995-2000

The government of Robert Mugabe may have been as firmly in power in 2000 as it was in 1995, but the intervening years saw severe economic crisis, mass strikes and protests, the start of land occupations, intervention in the war in the DRC, and the rise of the opposition Movement for Democratic Change.

Shereen Essof shows how Zimbabwean women crafted responses to these and other events, and aimed for a feminist agenda that would prioritise the interests of the rural and urban poor. Rejecting both the strictures of patriarchy and the orthodoxies of established feminism, she demands that Zimbabwe's women be heard in their own voices and in their own contexts. In doing so she writes a book that combines scholarly integrity with a wild, joyous cry for liberation.
