Conferência: Introductory Comparative Study on Asian Approaches to Africa, Prof. Takuo Iwata

A Conferência no âmbito das actividades do Mestrado e do Doutoramento em Estudos Africanos é organizada conjuntamente com o CEA-ISCTE sob o título “Introductory comparative study on Asian approaches to Africa”.

Abstract

Since last decade, Asian countries became more noticeable in Africa. “China in Africa”, then “India in Africa” have been studied in academism. We have a ready seen enormous research products about “China in Africa”. Before China and India, the issue “Japan in Africa” was much focused in 1990s. While Asian Approaches to Africa have been studied, we don’t meet sufficient comparative studies on African policy among Asian countries. This modest research project aims to understand Asian approaches to Africa through comparative studies concerning involvements of four major Asian partners (China, India, Japan, and South Korea).

By this work, I try to find common and different points to grasp the comprehensive image on Asian approaches to Africa. Today’s presentation is still preparatory phase for such huge subject. The work needs to access more detailed information to be able to achieve sufficient comparative analysis.



African Studia, Nº 15. Autoridades Tradicionais Africanas durante o Período Colonial

A análise do chamado “poder tradicional” é um dos temas mais recorrentes dos estudos africanos desde a formação desta área de estudos e, ao mesmo tempo, um verdadeiro campo de batalha académico.

A presença de “chefes tradicionais” não é, em si, específico da África subsariana. Até às discussões mais recentes, nunca foi convincentemente explicado quais os critérios objectivos para separarmos, de maneira conceptual, um “rei” ou “nobre com terra” de qualquer sociedade da Europa, do Próximo Oriente, da Ásia oriental ou meridional, de um chamado “chefe tradicional” da África subsariana, da América do Norte, ou da Oceânia, para mencionarmos apenas algumas zonas típicas da discussão.


É evidente que a expressão “chefe tradicional” foi reservada para as zonas supostamente menos “desenvolvidas” e mais “tribais” (do ponto de vista dos autores da tipologia).

O título *Moçambicanidades Disputadas* trata das relações entre migração internacional moçambicana e processos identitários. Tomando como unidades de análise as festas-cerimónias comemorativas, em Moçambique e em Portugal, mostra que estas são um palco privilegiado para o estudo de identidades, culturas e relações de poder. Demonstra ainda o papel determinante dos imigrantes na negociação da moçambicanidade. Do ponto de vista teórico, traz um contributo crítico às interpretações centradas no Estado-nação (causalidade cumulativa) e na globalização (difusão), propondo o conceito de identidade xithike.

Eugénio Santana é moçambicano, antropólogo e músico. É professor universitário na Universidade Eduardo Mondlane e investigador do Centro de Estudos de Migrações, Inter-Etnicidade e Transnacionalismo e do Instituto Superior de Arte e Cultura de Moçambique.




Trata-se, portanto, de um documento reflexivo e de um instrumento importante para a análise dos processos de paz e transição para a democracia.

The Anglophone Cameroon Predicament

Explores the predicament of Anglophone Cameroon from the experiment in federation from 1961 to the political liberalisation struggles of the 1990s to challenge claims of a successful post-independence Cameroonian integration process. Focusing on the perceptions and actions of people in the Anglophone region, Atanga argues that what has come to be called the Anglophone Problem constitutes one of the severest threats to the post-colonial nation-state project in Cameroon.

As a linguistic and cultural minority, Anglophone Cameroonians realised that the Francophone-led state and government were keener in assimilation than in implementing the federal and bilingual nation agreed upon at reunification in 1960.

Calls for national integration became simply a subterfuge for the assimilation of Anglophones by Francophones who dominated the state and government.



Adjaye - Africa - Architecture: A Photographic Survey of Metropolitan Architecture

At just over forty, David Adjaye is one of the world's most exciting and accomplished architects, and has built many highly acclaimed houses and public buildings in the UK and USA. Over a ten-year period, the Tanzanian-born, London-based architect has visited 53 major African cities and photographed thousands of buildings, sites and places that few of us will ever be able to visit.

This 7-volume slip-cased edition documents Adjaye's tribute to African metropolitan architecture. The individual volumes present cities according to the terrain in which they are situated: the Maghreb, Desert, The Sahel, Savannah and Grassland, Mountain and Highveld, and Forest.



African's Odious Debts: How Foreign Loans and Capital Flight Bleed a Continent

Argues that Africa, far from being a drain on the financial resources of the West, is actually a net creditor to the rest of the world.

The extent of capital flight from sub-Saharan Africa is remarkable: more than \$700 billion in the past four decades. But Africa's foreign assets remain private and hidden, while its foreign debts are public, owed by the people of Africa through their governments.

More than half of the money borrowed by African governments in recent decades departed in the same year, with a significant portion of it winding up in private accounts at the very banks that provided the loans in the first place.

Meanwhile, debt-service payments continue to drain scarce resources from Africa, cutting into funds available for public health and other needs.



Contemporary Francophone African Writers and the Burden of Commitment

By looking at engagée literature from the recent past, when the francophone African writer was implicitly seen as imparted with a mission, to the present, when such authors usually aspire to be acknowledged primarily for their work as writers, this study addresses the current processes of canonization in contemporary francophone African literature.

Odile Cazenave and Patricia Célérier argue that aesthetic as well as political issues are now at the forefront of debates about the African literary canon, as writers and critics increasingly acknowledge the ideology of form. Working across genres but focusing on the novel, the authors take up the question of renewed forms of commitment in this literature. Their selected writers range from Mongo Beti, Ousmane Sembène, and Aminata Sow Fall to Boubacar Boris Diop, Véronique Tadjo, Alain Mabanckou, and Léonora Miano, among others.



Maldevelopment: Anatomy of a Global Failure

Explores the wide gulf between our view of ourselves, how we are seen by others, and the dispassionate images seen through the cold lens of a camera.

Angus has been traumatised by his time on the Border and now begins to film himself doing ordinary things, to try to understand his life.

It is impossible, he says, for an abnormal person to have a normal life in an abnormal city like Johannesburg. The effect of the Border War on young white males has received little attention from novelists.

New novelist James Clelland pulled off a coup last year, winning the EU Literary Award 2010 for *Deeper Than Colour*, a novel so often rejected that it had not even been published when it was submitted for the prize. He is a tall, friendly man in a bright Indian-style shirt and with a strong Scottish accent.

SA PEN's main purpose is to encourage literature in the 15 SADC countries from which the original short-stories were received.



They had everything, including two golden children - a girl and a boy. However, life became increasingly difficult and they moved to Rhodesia to work as farm managers.

The previous farm manager had committed suicide. His ghost appeared at the foot of their bed and seemed to be trying to warn them of something. Shortly after this, one of their golden children died. Africa was no longer the playground of Nicola's childhood. They returned to England where the author was born before they returned to Rhodesia and to the civil war. The last part of the book sees the Fullers in their old age on a banana and fish farm in the Zambezi Valley.



Pilgrimage plays an important role in reintegrating some of those fragmented worlds into something approaching wholeness.







Novo website para rastrear as origens de Africanos escravizados

Pouco se sabe acerca da ancestralidade de africanos carregados pelo comércio transatlântico de escravos. Um novo website, lançado pela Emory University essa semana, visa suprir tal lacuna.

A página **Origens Africanas** oferece raras informações sobre as identidades de africanos transportados por navios negreiros em princípios do século dezenove e, com tais dados, a possibilidade de traçar as origens de milhares de outros africanos carregados à força para as Américas. A participação do público será fundamental na construção dessa história, ainda inexistente.

O projeto é resultado do trabalho de G. Ugo Nwokeji e David Eltis que, em 2002, utilizaram nomes gravados em áudio encontrados nos arquivos das Comissões Mistas de Havana, Cuba, e Freetown, Serra Leoa, para identificar suas prováveis origens etno-lingüísticas.

Os nomes gravados foram pronunciados por pessoas fluentes na mesma língua e sotaque que os oficiais das Comissões Mistas provavelmente falavam (por exemplo, Eltis e Nwokeji utilizaram um falante de espanhol com sotaque cubano para pronunciar nomes encontrados em registros de Havana). Através das gravações, esses indivíduos foram capazes de identificar o provável grupo étnico ao qual o nome pertencia.

Apesar do sucesso da pesquisa individual com informantes, a mesma se mostrou extremamente trabalhosa em termos de tempo gasto e resultou em pouco mais do que duas identificações para cada africano existente no banco de dados. Isso levou os pesquisadores a buscar um método online que possibilitasse a participação de voluntários interessados em contribuir para o projeto.



The South African Research Chair in Social Change (hosted by the University of Johannesburg) welcomes applications for the following: **3** post-doctoral fellowships (PDFs); **3** doctoral bursaries; **5** masters bursaries and **2** honours bursaries

The Chair is funded by the Department of Science and Technology and administered by the National Research Fund (NRF). The chair holder is Prof. Peter Alexander. Dr. Marcelle Dawson has been seconded to the chair as a senior researcher and most of the above positions are linked to her proposed NRF Thuthuka project. Further support for these positions is provided by the University of Johannesburg (UJ) and by the university's Faculty of Humanities. Bursaries are linked to students who are registered on a UJ programme. Doctoral and masters students must be supervised or co-supervised by either Dr. Dawson or Prof. Alexander, but the chair is interdisciplinary and can assist with locating additional supervision. - 1) Post-doctoral fellowships are open to candidates of any nationality.
- 2) Non-South Africans can be considered for doctoral and masters bursaries, but the NRF limits availability.
- 3) Honours bursaries are only available to black South African students.

All applicants should submit a CV, transcript, names and contact details of three academic referees, and a covering letter indicating which of the research project/s you are interested in.
